Jazz pianist Justin Kauflin is a versatile leader performer, composer and producer with ten albums and contributions to over 40 projects. He composed the score and is featured in the Oscar-shortlisted documentary "Keep On Keepin' On" which honors his mentor, Clark Terry. He subsequently worked and toured with Quincy Jones for a decade. Currently, Justin teaches at the Governor's School for the Arts, produces a free concert series, hosts live streams, and serves as a Jazz Ambassador for the U.S. State Department. After losing his sight at age 11, he collaborates with companies to improve technological accessibility for visually-impaired musicians and producers.
